CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION AT SHOWS AT RAC and entry to our premises

1. All riders must abide by British Showjumping/Dressage/Showing rules at all times.
2. RAC, it's officials and those working for it disclaim any responsibility for any accident to persons, animals or property, howsoever caused, whilst on it's premises. RAC accepts no responsibility for anything left behind by visitors and will not forward anything on by post or any other means or replace them - whether subsequently found or not.
3. Bad behaviour will not be tolerated. We reserve the right to ban anyone from participating without refund of fees for any behaviour which in the opinion of the organisers has caused trouble or upset to anyone.
4. Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times & will not be allowed in the bar/café/shopping mall or restaurant.
5. BS Rule 76 may be applied in the event of insufficient starters for any show jumping classes except where specifically stated in a schedule. No stabling fees are refundable after closing date.
6. Anyone found mucking out their lorry onto the car park or fields will be asked to leave immediately. You may use our dung heap for your horse refuse. Household waste must be put into the dustbins. Lorry waste may be emptied into our septic tank.
7. We reserve the right to change start times & swop rings for classes if competitor numbers or weather dictate subject to BS approval. We also reserve, subject to BS approval, the right to cancel or amalgamate classes in cases of insufficient entries.
8. Anyone not collecting their prize money properly dressed and mounted will have their prize money withheld although it will be credited to their horse/pony winnings.
9. Please ensure you only use designated areas to exercise your animals whilst at RAC. Please keep off our lawns and landscaped areas.
10. No food or drink may be consumed on our premises except those purchased from ourselves.
11. No one shall allow a stallion for which they are responsible as owner, lessee, authorised agent or rider to compete or be prepared to compete in any show jumping competition without taking adequate precautions to ensure other members of the public or riders are not put at risk of injury.
12. Please keep to the designated horse areas and do not mingle with the general public on a horse or pony.
13. Anyone entering the class without seeing the secretary first will be charged £10 extra. Once the class has started no refunds will be given. Changing classes will be free if already entered. Late entries will cost £5 plus entry fee. Late declarations will cost £10. In pre entry shows no refunds after drawn orders have been done. All entries for pre entry classes and shows must be guaranteed by a credit card. Money will be taken for all monies owing at end of show. Anyone entering a class & not withdrawing from it will be charged the full entry fee.
14. Anyone leaving the show without paying will have a charge of £20 added to their bill & will thereafter be refused credit at all shows. Payment in future will have to be made in full by cash with entry. No cheques will be accepted.
15. Anyone bouncing a cheque will be charged £35 & will have to clear their debts with us before further entries will be taken.
16. All credit & debit cards will have a £3 transaction charge levied.
17. All competitors including visiting foreign & Irish riders and all their horses/ponies must be current full or temporary members of British Showjumping in order to compete. Please note that foreign riders, whether members of BS or not, are not eligible to compete or qualify in certain national Championships in accordance with rule 33.12 (.2 & .4)
